RE: MRFD Agenda 6/9/20: COMMUNICATIONS

Chief Newman and Board of Trustees, Missoula Rural Fire District

As noted in MRFD's 6/9/20 agenda; Trustee Dick Mangan suggested (MRFD owns the property outright) developing covenants on the sale (if the property is sold) as to what can or cannot be done with the property and put (some) restrictions on the sale. In addition, it was noted that the Chief should check briefly with the County to see if this was something MRFD could do.

We will provide our input regarding covenants to follow in this communication. But first, we are confused as to what the County has to do with a MRFD decision. In an earlier communication we received from Commissioner Strohmaier (5/19/20) he states, MRFD is not a part of county government so we have no jurisdiction regarding the relocation of the property. Why would the county have jurisdiction regarding MRFD developing covenants on the property?

The development of covenants on the sale of Station #4, is warranted. We trust that the BOT will review and act on the concerns that we outlined in our correspondence to MRFD dated 5/19/20.

The structure of the building lends itself to an automotive/trucking service/sales facility given the large bay area and paved apron. Covenants that disallows junk/non-running/ in-need-of-service vehicles on site will satisfy a number of our earlier outlined concerns: compliments the neighborhood, does not disrupt quality of life, does not degrade air/water quality, does not increase traffic or create parking issues. This is but one extreme scenario that would not bode well or be accepted in the immediate neighborhood.

Additionally, our wellhead is 46' from the concrete cistern on the west side of the station, 56' from the building. Without knowing whether or not the building is in compliance with County Ordinances for sanitation, we have concerns as to the separation between the building and our well. Hence our concern regarding the potential for groundwater pollution.

Please include this correspondence in your next MRFD Board Agenda. We remain open to our communication with MRFD throughout the decision making process. Thank you.

July 2020 IT Report

- TeleStaff version upgrade and server migration completed. Now running as a Virtual Machine (VM) which means that it is easily backed up and quickly restored in the event of a hardware failure. This also frees up server hardware so that a reallocation of resources will lead to higher level of fault tolerance by providing an additional VM host.
- Completed existing Skype Room System at Station 1 reconfiguration. Due to a “pushed out” software update this computer was rendered unusable for meetings. After many hours of struggling with finding a fix it became apparent the best approach would be to convert this dedicated Skype/Teams system to a general purpose computer capable of conducting meetings using any of the commonly used platforms such as Teams, WebEx, Zoom, and others.
- Teams usage planning with administrative group, and misc. others. Online meetings is only one component of the Teams Collaboration Platform that also provides other components such as file sharing, chatting, and workflow timeline and progress tracking for projects and programs. As such we will be investigating how this can be utilized at MRFD.
- Set up webcams on administrative computers.
- Assisted with a couple of I.T. related components of the modified Timecards spreadsheet.
- Assisted with a couple of I.T. related components of new Training Request procedure.
- Reorganize shared data storage and folder hierarchy - S: drive
- Scanning folder problems and additional scanning folders
- Assist with SOG folder permissions
- Assist with Admin folder permissions
- Minor modifications to all MDTs
- Corrected some TeleStaff logins
- Assisted with a couple of I.T. related components of new First Due response pre-plan software
- And misc other things

August 2020 IT Report

- Apparatus cell phone tracking “Find My Phone”
- CAD View logging out frequently – Taylor Tech corrected problem
- Workstation stn1crew1 running unusably slow after MS operating system update. Swapped out with backup workstation. Research indicates many others with same problem. Applied fixes and swapped back into service, but slowness returned. Backup back in use and researching further.
- First Due preplan software settings/configuration and install on MDTs
- With the end of life coming up for Skype for Business, began renaming Skype Room meeting computers to more generic names – StationMeeting1, etc. This will include a full update to Windows 10 for all station’s Skype computers.
- Attempted setting up one of the old laptops for Dr. Gildea to use for accessing New World Reporting system. Old laptop too out of date, so setting up a login with restrictions to new Remote Desktop Services (RDS) system, allowing access through his own computer.
- Engineers Training Class presentation on IT considerations and reconfiguring up an MDT for training usage.
- Domain name registration – extended MRFD1.FIRE.ORG for two years and registered MCFD1.ORG for one year.
- 310 MDT randomly locking up or resetting. Swapped out with spare. Still evaluating but appears to be hardware related. This MDT indicates over 33,000 hours of run time (approaching 4 years). We may need to budget a replacement plan for MDTs.
- Assisted with new automated Training Request system development

Miscellaneous items included fax machine maintenance, mouse replacements for a few computers, firewall settings, assist end user’s setup for meetings and classes, HipLink usage, and end user questions.

And utilized comp time and vacation time to take off several afternoon per week.

Call for Service Report July 2020

In July of 2020, Missoula Rural Fire District (MRFD) answered 254 calls for service. MRFD responded to 241 of these incidents. The other 13 incidents were responded to solely by mutual aid partners. MRFD provided mutual aid on 71 incidents and received mutual aid on 44 incidents, overall working side by side with 8 neighboring agencies.
